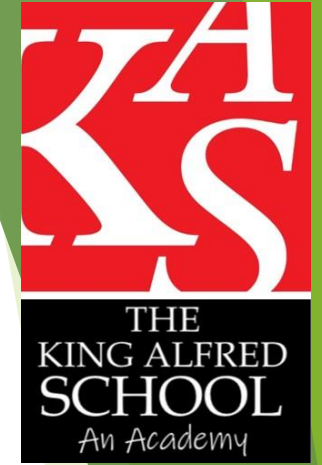

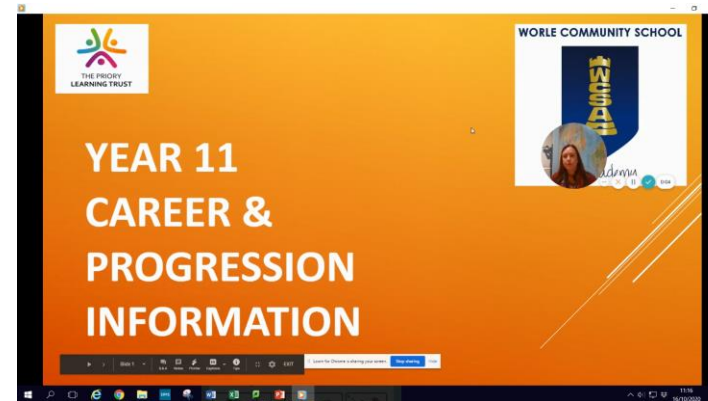

- ▶ T - Levels are the equivalent of three A Levels. They combine classroom theory, practical learning and an industry placement to ensure students have the skills to thrive in the world of work.
- ▶ As well as offering a clear line of sight to industry, T Levels are recognised by UCAS to support applications to study at university.
